

# Lithuania Stakeholder Workshop

Organised by Lithuanian University of Health Sciences LUHS  
16 March 2018  
Summary

A workshop for stakeholders was organized with special emphasis to provide knowledge about evidence-based correlations and thereby offer opportunities to develop ideas and starting point for innovative solution in the area of fracture management.

Representatives of implant manufacturers, implant suppliers, manufacturers of orthopaedic braces and other devices, rehabilitation institutions and project executors were participating in the meeting.

During the workshop meeting information about BFCC project was presented by prof. Š. Tarasevičius. Project partners, aims, transnational fracture registry, study pilots and initial outcomes were presented. Possible opportunities to collaborate were discussed. It was suggested by the implant braces or other orthopaedic device manufacturers that BFCC project is an interesting knowledge platform. They would like to know the distribution of the products, reasons for usage and new approach of clinical problems.
